Yarding 366 Change +41

An overall yarding of 366 fat and store cattle were on offer at the Inglis livestock selling centre this week. The market this week for all types of export bulls sold firm with the best bulls topping at 186 cents to be 4 cents dearer. The cow market continues to be strong with all grades lifting by 4 to 5 cents/kg. Limited numbers of export steers and bullocks sold to a fully firm trend. Another quality offering of yearling trade cattle were on offer. Heavy descriptions sold to a firm trend whilst lighter types sold 4 to 5 cents easier. A good offering of store steers and heifers sold firm to 5 cents/kg dearer.

* Producers are advised to take advantage of the dearer prices on offer at the moment.

Vendors are reminded it is compulsory that all cattle must have an NLIS device in their ear prior to leaving any property for any reason. This includes cattle consigned to a saleyard. If you do not have suitable facilities to apply devices safely or have run out of devices, you MUST seek permission from the Moss Vale Rural Lands Protection Board on 4655 9165 to move the unidentified cattle. Emergency NLIS devices will not be made available as a means of expediency meaning that your cattle cannot be sold.
